### **PTSA Reflections Contest**

The Raisbeck Aviation PTA is looking for art submissions for this year's National PTSA Reflections contest. The Reflections Contest is a themed, national contest. It encourages students to represent their school by expressing themselves through the arts. The theme this year is: "Show Your Voice!"

Students will compete in the High School Division for grades 9-12. Students can submit to more than one category but are only allowed one submission per category. The categories are: Dance, Film, Literature, Music Composition, Photography, and Visual Arts

Your contest submission, along with a <u>student entry form</u>, must be completed and submitted by **Monday**, **November 29th**. After the PTSA has received all submissions, local artists will review the submissions and decide which submissions should advance to the state level. At the state level, students' submissions will compete against other high schoolers in the state. The winners at the state level will go on to compete nationally in Washington D.C.
