Thank you if you already completed and submitted your grad party packet for the 2021 RAHS PTSA Grad Party. If you have not turned in your grad packet yet, the final date to pay and turn in your required grad packet is June 9, 2021. I will be at RAHS Wednesday to collect and verify grad packet forms. Please come prepared with your grad packet signed by your guardians and yourselves, printed names and dates on all appropriate lines. If in doubt...sign & print your name! Please complete all medical insurance info, even if you do not have meds or other items on the form to disclose. Parents/guardians must sign this form even if you are 18 now or at the event.

The Grad Party is an event that the RAHS PTSA organizes. It is not a school sponsored event. This event provides seniors an opportunity for a safe, drug and alcohol-free entertaining celebration with your 2021 graduating classmates. Every year some don't attend and then wish they had. This event is for every grad from Raisbeck Aviation HS...together we are better! It's not too late to join the fun! We want all of our RAHS Grads at the party!

This year's celebration party will be held at DEFY Seattle, in Tukwila, WA June 10, 2021 from 11:00 PM to 2:00 AM. Please arrive at 10:45 PM for initial check-in with parent chaperones. Defy will open doors at 11:00 PM sharp and no late entry after 11:15 PM. Park in the covered garage. We will not use the front entrance to the building.

There is no transportation for this event. Please drive yourself only if your license allows driving during the hours of the party **OR** have your parent/guardian drop you off. Pick up is required at 2:00 AM. There will not be adults staying late, so please be on time. Please contact the Grad Committee at gradparty@rahsptsa.org with any questions about transportation.

Parking and drop off/pick up will be in the covered parking garage at the back of the Defy complex. Please clean cars out and do not leave valuables in your car prior to coming, especially visible bags or backpacks, etc. Park and make your way to the check-in table near the garage entrance to Defy. There you will get checked in and line up for the doors to open. Security will be at this event. All bags will be checked and a quick pat down will be required by security to enter the facility. Only empty water bottles are permitted. We have drinks & water for you, so there is no need to bring your own bottle for this event.

Here are a few basic rules we want you to be aware of:

- Do not bring backpacks, purses or any other bag. If you bring these items, they will be subject to search by Security Personnel or required to be "checked in" with a Chaperone prior to entering the event.
- Behave in a respectful manner in regards to the facilities, games, equipment and staff at the event. Students who act in a manner which poses risk to others, games, or facility, may be required to be picked up by their parents. Refunds for such actions will not be granted.
- You may not leave the event unless prior written arrangements have been made. Students who do arrange in writing to leave early, will only be picked-up by their parents or authorized adult.

Below is a list of items you may NOT bring:

- Personal Water Bottles or Beverage Containers that have not been monitored by chaperones
- Pocket Knives, Metal Nail Files or any sharp objects or Weapons (such as firearms of any kind)
- Illegal Substances (such as Marijuana, Alcohol, Cigarettes, Vaping Paraphernalia, Cigars, etc.)

Students found to be in possession of illegal substances or an item that may endanger others will be required to be picked up by their parents.

All completed Registration Forms must be turned in to the Grad Party Planning Committee prior to the event. Students with incomplete Registration Forms may not be allowed to enter the venue until all forms are complete. If student requires assistance during the event, please indicate on the Registration Form so that prior arrangements can be made. Only RAHS 2021 Graduates are permitted entrance to this event.
