Students - PE contracts during school closure: Rules and requirements for PE contracts have been relaxed during our school closure. Here are the changes, which we hope make it easier for you to start or complete a PE contract while school is closed.

- •We will accept parent signatures in place of an outside supervisor for PE contracts
- •We will accept emails from a coach/supervisor in place of a physical signature

•We will accept at-home activities like workouts (students can access workout routines, videos, etc. online as a resource for this), neighborhood walking or running, and other options that do not require going to a gym or group gathering

•Students can use the above types of at-home activities to complete a contract that is already in progress, even if they started with a different activity – for example, if a student was going to a local gym, or playing a rec league sport (including Turbulence ultimate), they can complete their remaining contract hours with a personal fitness activity at home

•Contract forms can be submitted via email to Jacob.savishinsky@highlineschools.org

•Contracts can be extended into the summer, but **activity hours** must be completed before school starts up in the fall (contract forms can be completed after we return to school)
